

# ENEA INTERNATIONAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME 2011

## THE ESSENTIALS

**Please note that the present document does not in itself have any legal value, and thus does not supersede the Competition announcement published on the ENEA website.**

### **What is the purpose of the ENEA International Fellowship Programme?**

The ENEA International fellowship programme aims at helping young researchers to reach or reinforce a position of professional maturity and independence. The duration of these fellowships is of 6 months.

### **Who can apply?**

Early-stage researchers, willing to spend a mobility period working in ENEA research centers. Early-stage researchers are defined as those in the first four years of their research careers, starting at the date of obtaining the degree which would formally entitle them to embark on a doctorate, irrespective of whether or not a doctorate is envisaged.

### **Which research topics are supported?**

Full details on the research topics are described in the document named “Open calls”.

### **What does the funding cover?**

ENEA funding covers:

- a) a monthly living allowance of €2000
- b) a round trip travel allowance, upon taking up the fellowship, varying from the distance between fellow’s location of origin and Italy, calculated as follows:
  - maximum of €300 for intra-European destinations
  - maximum of €900 for intercontinental destinations

### **When to apply?**

The deadline for applications is September 21, 2011.

### **How to apply?**

Proposals are submitted by recorded mail ONLY.

### **Which individual researchers can take part?**

To be able to participate in the ENEA International Fellowship Programme a number of eligibility criteria must be fulfilled.

After the deadline, submitted proposals will be checked for eligibility. Those proposals that do not meet the criteria will not undergo scientific evaluation and will be rejected. To be eligible, the criteria need to be fulfilled at the time of the deadline for submission.

The eligibility criteria will be checked based on the information given by the applicant in the proposal. If at a later stage, an eligibility criterion is found not to be fulfilled, this will instantly lead to the rejection of the proposal.

**How will the proposals be evaluated?**

Proposals that fulfill eligibility criteria will undergo scientific evaluation. All eligible proposals will be evaluated by a panel of experts (so called “Examining board”) and will be based upon the information provided by the researcher according to the documents requested in the ENEA competition announcement. Please note that incomplete applications will not be taken into account.
