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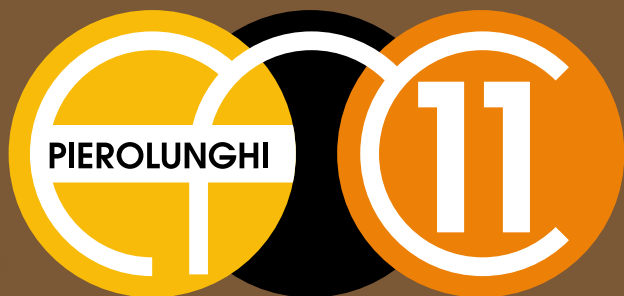

Along the years, EFC has become a major appointment for fuel cells experts, such as researchers and scientists, industry representatives, investors and policy makers, so that the 2007 and 2009 editions each boasted more than 250 participants coming from all over the world. EFC09 counted on 175 scientific contributions by international leading experts in the field of fuel cells. 71 of the 175 final papers were selected for publication in 2 specialistic journals: "ASME Journal of Fuel Cell Science and Technology" and "International Journal of Hydrogen Energy".
