ENEA is the Italian National Agency for New Technologies, Energy and Sustainable Economic Development and hosts over 2700 staff employees, distributed in its 9 research centers all over the national territory.

EIT Raw Materials has been designated as an EIT Knowledge and Innovation Community (KIC) by the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT, Budapest).

116 European partners, including ENEA, are part of the EIT Raw Materials; it is the largest partnership ever gathered in the field of strategic raw materials.

EIT Raw Materials is a European Network that acts in the field of 'strategic' raw materials, built to create, among other things, start-ups and new jobs throughout Europe.

The project will involve the most important European partners (universities, research centers, firms), to improve the extraction, recycling, reuse and replacement of raw materials, in particular those considered "critical", such as rare earths, indium, germanium, magnesium.

EIT Raw Materials is arranged into six nodes, coordinated by an international headquarter based in Germany, and the node for Southern Europe (Co-Location Centre - "South") is located in Italy, at ENEA Casaccia Research Centre, near Rome.

The CLC-S will coordinate about 50 partners from Italy, Spain, Hungary and Malta.
